Find comfort, the LORD is with us. In the furnace with us—so that we will come out unharmed.


Alleluia! Christ is risen! Christ is risen indeed. Alleluia!


#### MOMENT OF THANKSGIVING

As we prepare for this Thanksgiving meal, let us pause and reflect on what we are thankful for since we last received Holy Communion.

WORDS OF INSTITUTION The Lord be with you. And also with you.

Lift up your hearts. We lift them to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. It is right to give him thanks and praise. In the night in which he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus took bread, and gave thanks; broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying: Take and eat; this is my body, given for you. Do this for the remembrance of me.

For as often as we eat of this bread and drink from this cup we proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

Therefore, gracious Father, with this bread and cup we remember the life our Lord offered for us.


And, believing the witness of his resurrection, we await his coming in power to share with us the great and promised feast.

#### Amen. Come, Holy Spirit.


Join our prayers with those of your servants of every time and every place, and unite them with the ceaseless petitions of our great high priest until he comes as victorious Lord of all.

forever and ever. Amen.




