
SRLC Camera Instructions - April 2024

****ON THE BACK OF THE CAMERA REMOTE, THE VIEWS ARE LISTED BY #. USE #2 - ALTAR-FULL

Before church, around 9:50 AM...

 Find the little black wire with a round top (this is the power wire for the camera) and plug it into the bottom left on the back of the camera (DC 12 V). The camera should then move around.

(If the camera doesn't move, you didn't push the wire in far enough.)



2. Pick up the remote. Press the black, #2 button until the camera stops moving and is correctly lined up with the altar.



If nothing happens, press the WHITE 1 camera select button to make sure it's on camera 1 and push black number 2 button again (same button as in step 2). The camera should move.

Unplug the 2 receivers (RX) from the charger on the pew. (They are the ones with screens.) Plug both into the 2 red wires on the camera. PLUG THEM IN HARD - THEY MUST BE FLUSH OR THERE WON'T BE ANY SOUND.



- 4. Press and hold the black & white button turn them on.



5. Look in the bottom left corner of each receiver screen - the right triangle should be SOLID. If the triangle is not solid, push the dB button (1-3 times) on the bottom of the receiver until the triangle is SOLID.





 Take the 2 transmitters (TX) off the charger and go downstairs. (IF the mics are not charging, ask Pastor where they are.) Turn the 2 transmitters on (by pressing and holding the button on the top).



The mics are on and connected when each transmitter has 2 SOLID blue lights at the top. Put 1 transmitter on the lectern and 1 transmitter on Pastor's chair.





The TV can help you see what is being broadcast. Turn it on with the power button at the top on the back. This is not necessary for camera operation.

After church, as soon as the postlude is finished...

1. Pull the power wire out of the camera.



 Turn off the 2 receivers (press the same button on the top that turned them on) and plug them into the charger in the balcony. (Note - the wire color does not matter.)
